TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2008

APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION IN RESPECT OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN INTEGRATED HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE FACILITY, COMPRISING LONG AND SHORT STAY RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION (CLASS 8 & 10), OPEN SPACE, LANDSCAPING AND NEW ACCESS TOGETHER WITH VARIOUS WORKS INCLUDING DEMOLITIONS

AT THE ROYAL VICTORIA HOSPITAL SITE, 13 CRAIGLEITH ROAD, EDINBURGH, EH4 2DL

We act on behalf NHS Lothian.

As part of the Integrated Health and Social Care agenda, discussions have taken place between NHS Lothian (NHSL) and the City of Edinburgh Council (CEC) in relation to strategic planning and capacity requirements of care home provision in Edinburgh.

The Participants (NHSL and CEC) are working with Hubco to assist in developing a short, medium and long term accommodation strategy for older people in the Edinburgh area.

The care element will provide a range of accommodation (residential and non-residential) to meet the health and social care needs of older people.

The submission of this Proposal of Application Notice represents a component part of the Lothian wide strategy, and envisages the redevelopment of the Royal Victoria site to provide an integrated health and social care facility. The remainder of the site, it is proposed, will be marketed as a residential development opportunity.

PROPOSAL OF APPLICATION NOTICE

On behalf of our client, we submit herewith a Proposal of Application Notice in relation to an "application for planning permission in respect of the development of an integrated health and social care facility, comprising long and short stay residential accommodation (Class 8 & 10), open space, landscaping and new access together with various works including demolitions" at the Royal Victoria Hospital site, 13 Craigleith Road, Edinburgh, EH4 2DL.
