UPDATE: Community Action North (Nov 2017)

Community Action North has been awarded funding from the Scottish Government's Aspiring Communities fund until December 2018. This will



enable CAN to work with the community to establish CAN as a community development trust in North Edinburgh. A community development trust is an organisation led by a community board of trustees.

We would like to work with community councils, offer opportunities to take part in the training and for us to learn from your experiences as community-led organisation. We'd like to develop a good working relationship between all the community councils in the area and CAN so we can support each other, find ways of mutually benefiting each other and the community at large.

CAN recruitment: Julie Smith was appointed as CAN manager in October. Two new staffs, one Partnership Development Worker and one Community Development worker – expected to start in the New Year.

CAN Website: We are working to create a new online presence for CAN. This will go live in the New Year and could offer opportunities for local CCs to advertise meetings, campaigns, etc.
