## Madelvic House

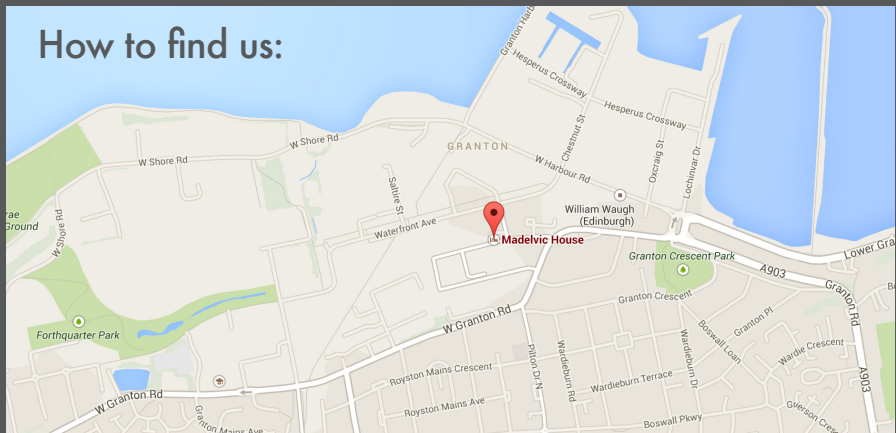
Waterfront Edinburgh Limited, City of Edinburgh Council, North Edinburgh Fights Back, Pilton Youth and Children's Project are all working together to find sustainable, long-term community uses for Madelvic House.

Madelvic House, Granton Park Ave, Edinburgh EH5 1HS was built as the offices for Madelvic Carriage Co, or Madelvic Motor Carriage Co Ltd (Granton) Edinburgh, which was formed in Edinburgh on January 19, 1898, by William Peck (1862 - 1925). Producing electric vehicles, Madelvic was one of the first Scottish motor marques, the first to have a purpose built car factory in Scotland.

**It is an important piece of local heritage and we are looking for people who live nearby that would be interested in supporting this project.**

We need to bring together a group of people who have enterprising ideas on how to use the building. So far we have considered adapting the building for use as a crèche or a café along with some business units on the upper floor but there are many possibilities. For instance, in another community hub in Dunbar they have got a bakery up and running. The potential uses are only limited to the imagination of the people who run it.
