- Submit your picture on the Edinburgh Outdoors facebook page, on twitter@ EdinOutdoors or by emailing it to <a href="mailto:parks@edinburgh.gov.uk">parks@edinburgh.gov.uk</a>. If you are using email, please resize it to smaller than 500kb.
- When submitting your photo, please make sure you let us know the location used.
- You can submit as many entries as you like. Entries will be judged and the top entries will be posted to a facebook gallery on the Edinburgh Outdoors page, for a public vote. The photos with the most likes will win.
- Please only submit your own original photographs, and ensure you do not infringe on the rights of others when you are taking them. You must have permission from any people featured in your entries, or of parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured.
- By entering the competition, you are granting City of Edinburgh Council, and Edinburgh Living Landscape partners, permission to reproduce any entries at no fee for the Edinburgh Living Landscape programme, Edinburgh Outdoors website and any other future promotional material. - Please only submit entries that have not been offered for sale, won or been runner up for any other photography competitions.
