The Minis organised and ran a very successful fundraising fun day at the Centre last month and also unveiled a memorial bench to wee Kai Laidlaw (*above*). Well done, Claire and Danielle!

**Sandra and Mark** are both working with adults in substance recovery in North Edinburgh. Sandra is working with a local group to break down barriers of isolation through social activities (based on a successful project she is involved in in Leith), while Mark will volunteer with a number of agencies to gain the experience which will, in time, enable him to devise his own programme to offer support to local people in recovery.

Our latest recruit is **Sara**, who will be supported by Pilton Community Health Project. Among her many community interests Sara is passionate about the local environment and much of her work will focus on supporting West Pilton Park Action Group activities.
