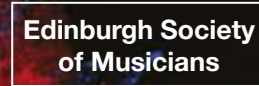

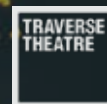

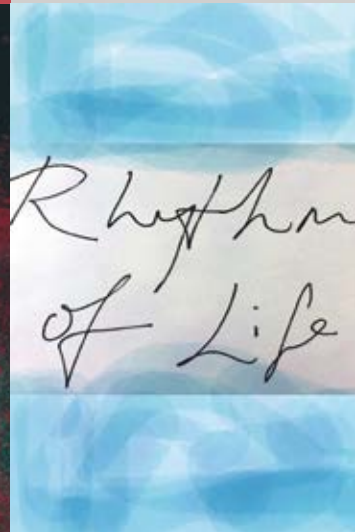
Rhythm of Life: Musical Mash-Up
