The Community Council Liaison Officer will retain the name and address of all elected members for the purpose of contacting them on matters relating to community councils.

Candidates, being either successful or unsuccessful, will be informed as soon as practicable about the outcome of the poll.

All election materials, including nomination papers, will be retained by the Council for a period of one year and thereafter securely destroyed.
