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Edinburgh off-road paths Code of Conduct



Everyone



Please consider all other path users

Stay alert, especially if using headphones or your phone

Don't assume everyone can see or hear you



Keep left if possible and pass on the right

Please don't leave your rubbish behind



Cyclists



Use your bell -well in advance



Please give others space



Don't pass at speed

At night - avoid dazzling: dip, dim, don't strobe



Walkers and runners



Listen for cyclists' bells



Allow cyclists to pass



At night, be safe be seen



Dog walkers

Keep dogs on a short lead or close to heel



Please clean up after your dog

At night, use a reflective collar or coat on your dog
