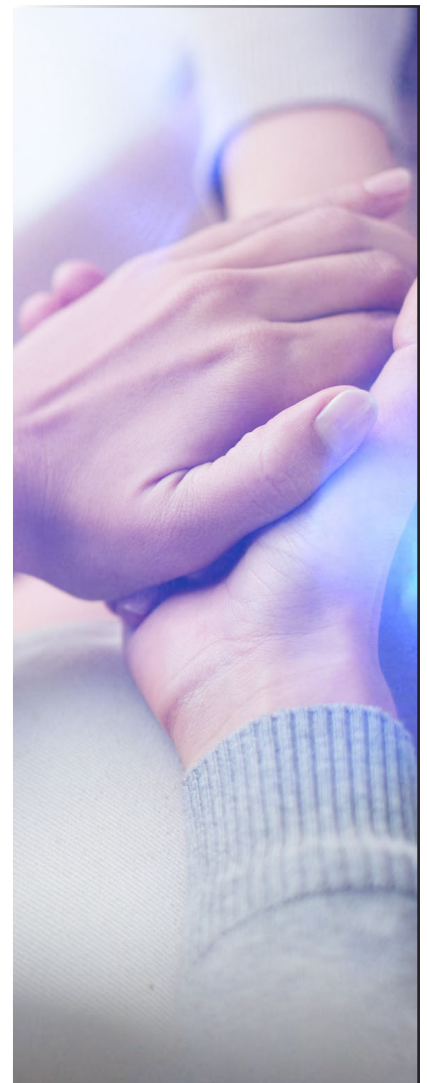

Telehealth

A series of free one-to-one sessions over the phone, video chat or instant messaging over 6 - 8 weeks. Available across Scotland.

Listening support and advice and an opportunity to speak to a professional counsellor in your local area. The service is free and is available across Scotland for anyone bereaved through drugs or alcohol.
