Summary

The pack contains:

- This **Information Booklet**.
- **Medication card**: detailing how and when you should take your treatment. Please carefully read through the guidance for pregnancy testing and contraception use.
- **Medication Appendix**: providing further information about the treatment you have been given.
- **Emergency Contact Card**: please give this card to any Healthcare provider you may have contact with.
- **Antiviral medication**.
- A **pre-paid envelope** to return any unused medication.
- A **pregnancy test** (for women of child-bearing age).

Following a negative pregnancy test result (if applicable), please take your medication for the *required number* of days. Please read the **Medication Card**

A trial Doctor or Research Nurse will call you on Day 1 to check that you have received your participant pack and taken your pregnancy test (if applicable), and on Day 2 to ask whether you have experienced any side-effects since starting your medication

For 28 days, we ask you to complete a short daily diary about your symptoms. If we do not receive your diary, we will call you and/or your trial partner to ask a few short questions on Days 7, 14 and 28.

- Please ensure that you submit your diary to us at the end of the questions, so we receive all of your answers.
- If we do not receive your completed diary, or you are unable to access the online diary, we will contact you and/or your nominated trial partner on day 7, day 14 and day 28 of the
- Follow up period to collect this information.

Finally, we will also ask that you, or someone close to you notifies us if you are admitted to hospital.

Summary

For 28 days, we ask you to complete a short daily diary about your symptoms. If we do not receive your diary, we will call you and/or your trial partner to ask a few short questions on Days 7, 14 and 28.

We will ask you to complete an online or over the phone questionnaire at 3 and 6 months after you started the trial, to find out about any ongoing symptoms and contact with healthcare providers.

Completing the daily online diary

Your short daily symptoms diary for 28 days. This will take less than ten minutes of your time each day.

- You will receive a daily email with an internet link, which will take you to a secure online system to collect your diary entries confidentially. **You can use the link from any day to access your diary.**
- You will receive a text asking you to submit your answers on the same day; you may prefer to do this at a regular time for your own convenience and routine.
- You will be asked to record whether you are experiencing a few symptoms, and to rate the severity of these symptoms.

We will ask you to complete an online or over the phone questionnaire at 3 and 6 months after you started the trial, to find out about any ongoing symptoms and contact with healthcare providers.

Taking your trial medication

Please see the **Medication Card** for guidance on how you should take your medication.

Participants of child-bearing age must complete the pregnancy test and confirm a negative result before starting the medication (instructions can be found on the medication card).

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
