What is this report about?

They have set **goals** to stop climate change getting worse.

A **goal** is what they are working towards.



Scotland has big plans to help everyone get better at coping with the problems that climate change will bring.

To do this the Scottish Government must do the right work at the right time.

What work needs to happen?



The way the Scottish Government is set up to deal with climate change has got better but there are things missing.



The Scottish Government needs to:

- do more to quickly reduce the harmful climate change gases Scotland is producing
- pay more attention to stopping the damage that climate change is already doing to Scotland.



They need to get better at reporting what they are doing so that the right people and groups in the Scottish Government know what work is happening.



They need to collect and share better information so that different people and groups in the Scottish Government know if work is happening quickly enough.



The Scottish Government need to make sure they have enough people with the right skills to achieve Scotland's climate change goals.

Managing risk



The Scottish Government and other experts have said that it is very likely that Scotland will not reach its climate change goals.

This means there is a **high risk** that climate change goals will not be met.




The Scottish Government needs to have good **risk management processes** in place.


This means understanding the things that might stop progress and having plans to deal with them.
