TRACEABILITY: Thoroughbred Census

First ever Thoroughbred Census launched in Great Britain by the Horse Welfare Board

Six-month initiative running to 31st December in partnership with Hartpury University

Will increase quality and quantity of data on horses retired from racing

Data will help the Horse Welfare Board and Retraining of Racehorses develop and adapt welfare initiatives

Promotes responsible ownership and the importance of updating equine ID documents at every change of ownership
