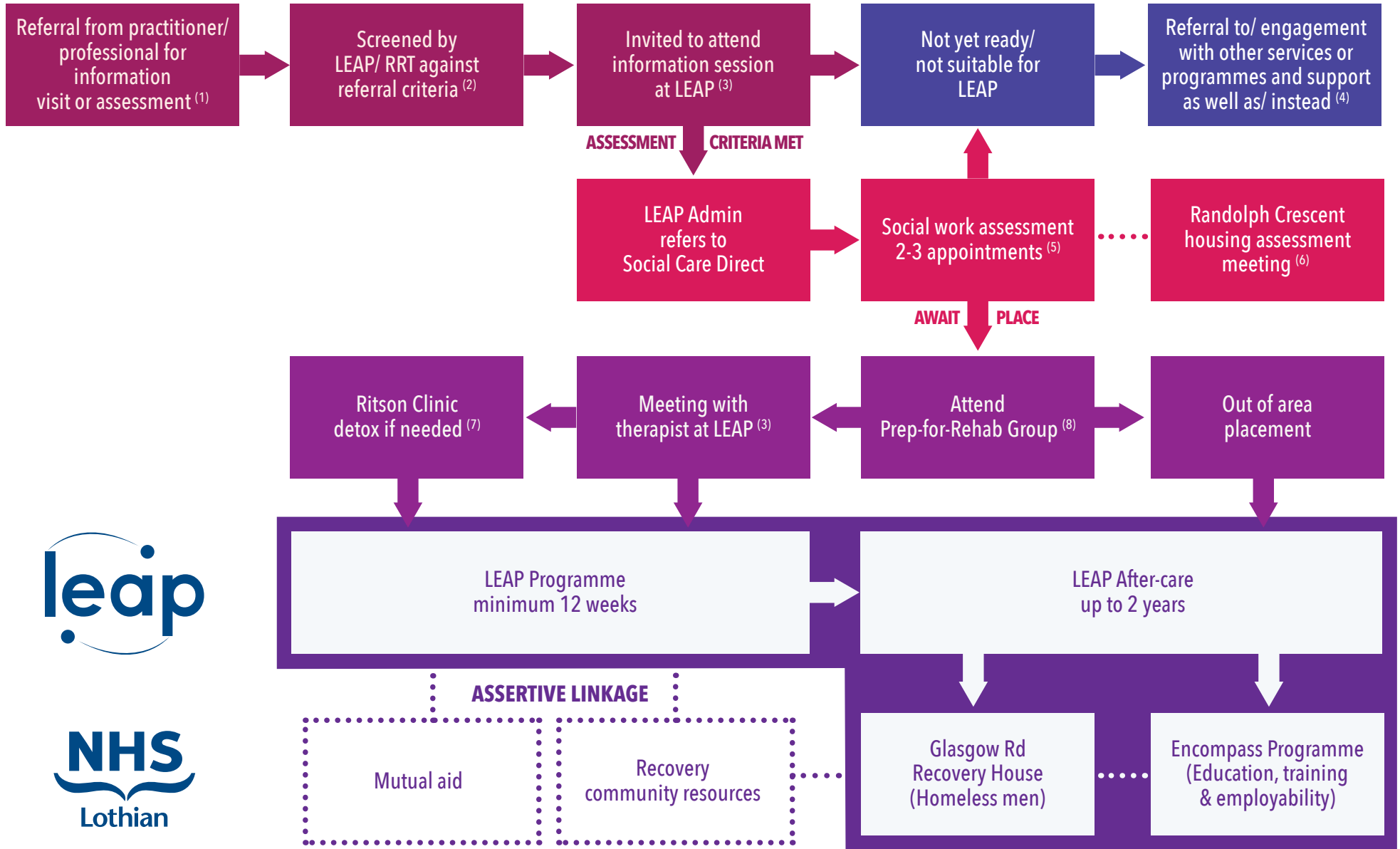

RESIDENTIAL REHAB PATHWAY NOTES (EDINBURGH)

- (1) e.g., CPN, GP, social worker, consultant, Turning Point, criminal justice, homelessness, learning disability or mental health services to single point of referral at LEAP by SCI Gateway, email, or letter:

- (2) Medication Referral Criteria:

- methadone 60mg (to reduce to 50mg by admission);
- diazepam 20mg;
- buprenorphine 20mg;
- Espranor 18mg;
- Buvidal 96mg.
